Katherine previously served as the external relations officer with the Winston-Salem office of Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC), a national nonprofit community development organization. Katherine has more than 8 years of experience working and volunteering with various nonprofit organizations throughout Winston-Salem.

## DR. MARY ANN TAYLOR, A VERY SPECIAL FRIEND

**D**ear ACS Family,  
Recently, we lost a dear friend, Dr. Mary Ann Taylor. Dr. Taylor was one of the founding trustees of AIDS Care Service in 1991. It was a time when an HIV+ diagnosis was a death sentence, and before the great anti-retroviral cocktail therapies came about. This was a time when people did not understand the disease. Fortunately, a few concerned members of the community came together in the basement of Knollwood Baptist Church to formulate ACS because it was the humane thing to do. Their mission, to help our brothers and sisters living with HIV disease improve their quality of life in a home like environment, was heavily influenced by Dr. Taylor. Their goal was to create a place for those dying of AIDS; their vision was Holly Haven Family Care Home.

Dr. Taylor, always with her dear husband at her side, worked tirelessly advocating in her communities for help for the HIV population. Mary Ann often encouraged her church, the medical community, and anyone who knew her to take action and help AIDS Care Service. The community rose to the needs often because of her passion and her no nonsense approach that *it was just the right thing to do*. She wore many hats. She



recruited other Board members, helped to secure Larry Roth as the founding Executive Director. She helped to research and write some of the first long range Strategic plans. She brought in furniture for the apartments. She delivered holiday sweets to the residents and staff. She was an amazing lady!

Early in my career with AIDS Care Service, I met for lunch with Larry and Dr. Taylor. We discussed the early years of the organization. She reminisced and shared how proud the founders would have been if they were still around to see all the accomplishments ACS had achieved. She said this with her well known warm smile and sparkle in her eye.

Dr. Taylor, we could not have it done without you. Thank you for all you have done to help ACS and we hope that we continue to make you proud. We are relying on your watchful eye from above and your whispered prayers. We have so many who need our help.

Nonprofit Management from UNCG. Along with his quick wit, André brings his expertise with community resources and referral to ACS.

In December ACS was blessed with the addition of Heather Hamby, the new administrator of Holly Haven Family Care Home. Heather previously worked with the Randolph County Family Crisis Center as the daytime shelter manager. Heather has a great deal of HIV disease experience and was a volunteer and intern with HOPE, formerly of Winston-Salem and Triad Health Project in Greensboro. HIV/AIDS awareness and prevention is Heather's passion, as well as her platform with her successful run on the North Carolina pageant circuit. Heather was recently crowned Miss Hickory 2005 and was the 1st runner-up and preliminary talent award winner at the 2005 Miss North Carolina Pageant. Brains, beauty, culture and compassion--we got it all with our staff at ACS.

Other changes occurred in October 2005 when ACS retooled the former Outreach Program to better meet the needs of our housing clients. Now named Client Supportive Services, the program offers important referrals, resources and life skills training to residents of Holly Haven and Horseshoe Transitional Apartments, providing a continuum of care for these clients. Headed up by André Brown, the program features "Back-to-Basics", a six-week training session providing clients important information about money management, rental skills, nutrition, healthcare management and other issues critical to self sufficiency. The program also provides follow-up support for persons receiving rental assistance from various funding sources such as the City's Shelter Plus Care program, federal Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA) funds, and Section 8 Housing from HUD. André will conduct home visits and follow-up phone calls to monitor our housing clients' health, housing conditions and general well being, providing the support that will help to ensure our clients success in living independently.

Four ACS programs (AMiGOS, Latino Client Health Education, Housing and Client Supportive Services) moved into a new location in January 2006. Located on Spruce Street, the space provides plenty of room for confidential client meetings as well as a large training space for AMiGOS meetings and "Back-to-Basics" trainings. Consolidating these programs allows for more instant collaboration within the programs. The move of the Housing program from one of the units at the Horseshoe transitional apartments has allowed ACS to provide yet another valuable housing opportunity for our clients.

An organizational development change came in the fall of 2005 when ACS has developed an internal program evaluation process. The evaluation is an approach that links objective measurements of program charters, operational functions and individual performance.

- **Program Charter:** Describes program history, needs, scope, goals, measurable outcomes and is annually reviewed.
- **Operational Functions:** Monthly reports ensure that the program is on track or determine if changes need to be made to meet annual objectives.
- **Individual Performance:** Annual individual performance reviews assess individual performance related to position expectations, program intentions, and agency priorities.

Bi-annual evaluations, conducted by the associate director of programs, will ensure program progress and efficiency. The results of the evaluations will become tools by which ACS sets program standards and strategic direction for the future.

All of these changes are ways that ACS ensures that we are meeting our mission by providing the best services to our clients through dedicated and talented staff, innovative programs and accountability measures.
