Our mission "is to empower and serve our brothers and sisters living with HIV/AIDS and to educate our community in the struggle against the disease. " Last year we served over 600 people living with HIV.

AIDS Care Service offers ten services:

- Holly Haven Family Care Home
- Housing Program (transitional housing units, housing vouchers, and emergency financial assistance)
- Food Pantry
- Back to Basics (life skills training)
- Positive Action Club Support Groups
- Comprehensive Risk Counseling (individualized risk reduction counseling for HIV+ clients)
- AMiGOS (volunteer lay health educator program)
- Latino Client Health Education (mirror of Comprehensive Risk Counseling)
- Ryan White HIV Case Management focused on the HIV+ Latino community
- HoMBReS Project (volunteer lay health education project utilizing male Latino soccer players to educate their teammates)

...Young people account for half of all new HIV infections worldwide (UNAIDS/WHO).

...In 2004 HIV/AIDS was the leading cause of death for black women in the U.S. ages 25 - 34 (CDC).

...In NC the rate of new infections is growing most rapidly among African-American women (NC Epi Data).
